Student Policy

Scheduling

- Private lessons are scheduled on availability during the week. They can range from one to two lessons per week. Private lessons are 1 hour.
- Group lessons are on a set schedule during the week. All beginner/intermediate Group lessons are 1 hour.
- Students who are late for group or private lessons should not expect to have more than the remaining time for their lesson.
- Punctuality is very important for training and extra physical activities for tardiness will be awarded to students.
- Tournaments/training events (away and local) are considered a lesson if they fall on the day of your lesson. The coach needs to be present at the event for this to take effect, since the coach will be coaching the player.
- Lessons are not canceled due to inclement weather unless an official notice from TS Badminton is released.
- Students must be dropped off at least 5 minutes before their lesson.
- Students must be picked up promptly at the end of the lesson.
- It is recommended for parents to come inside 10 min before a student's class ends (at least once a month) to talk about student progress.
- Coaches are not responsible for providing before or after lesson care for students.
- Parents are welcome to attend any lessons.
 - Please do not attempt to engage the coach about your child during another student's lesson
 - Please do not attempt to engage the coach during your own child's lesson, please save comments for after practice.
 - Please do not coach your child during a lesson (words of encouragement are always welcome)
- Make-up lessons will be given to students only for uncontrolled circumstances such as sickness or dangerous weather conditions that truly prevent you from coming to practice. TS Badminton will record your lesson in our system and will be scheduled at first availability. Monthly fee will not be changed due to cancellation.
- Lesson freezing can only occur twice a year. With a 1-month max unless a medical reason extends that time.
 - All efforts will be made to save the student's time slot.
 - Please let TS Badminton know a month or more in advance.
 - After the freeze time billing will occur. Emails will be sent out to the player before his lessons restart, but ultimately the class is the student's responsibility and make up class will not be given if their first classes are missed.
- There is a long wait list for students so if students cancel private lessons, their time slot will become available to other students. If they decide to come back, the normal \$50 initiation fee will be taken.



Fees

- Tuition is due on the 1st lesson of each month. Invoices will be sent out on the 1st of every month. Payment is due 4 days after receiving the invoice or 4 days after the first lesson.
- Tuition can be paid with credit card (3% fee) or ACH (bank transfer). Recurring payments through Square invoicing is the preferred payment.
- Tuition can be paid with cash or check as well, if necessary. And only after the ACH option is not possible.
 - Checks need to be made to Terminus Sports LLC.
- If tuition is overdue by 4 days, a late fee will be added on the 5th day. Every 5 days an additional late fee will be added up to a month. After a month of no payment your classes will be frozen until payment. This freeze will be a week. After that period your time slot will be given to other students.
- There is an initiation fee of \$50 for new students to cover admin fees.

Code of Conduct

- TS Badminton maintains an environment of respect and compassion in all of our events/clinics/lessons/sessions.
- All students, members, and visitors that are utilizing our facilities must adhere to all rules and policies and are expected to act in a safe, courteous, and respectful manner at all times.
- All requests and instructions by TS Badminton or Terminus Badminton staff should be strictly followed and failure to do so may result in any person, including members, being directed to leave the premises.

Prohibited conduct at TS Badminton during on or off-premises includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Foul, profane, or abusive language toward another person.
- Theft of any property
- Damaging the facilities of TS Badminton and the A5 Sportsplex in any way
- Threatening, harassing or intimidating any staff person, member, student, or visitor.
- Use of illegal drugs
- Possession of guns, knives, or other weapons
- Smoking
- Providing false information or records to TS Badminton, Terminus Sports, or A5 Sportsplex
- Selling products without consent of TS Badminton
- Additionally, any criminal activity or acts or threats of violence may be reported to the proper authorities and prosecuted.

TS Badminton and Terminus Badminton reserve the right to deny, suspend, revoke or limit access to events or facilities at its sole discretion in the case of any violation of this code of conduct or any rule or policy of the A5 Sportsplex, consistent with applicable law. Any questions arising regarding the meaning of any of the above rules should be brought to the attention of either the Head Coach (Thomas Shek) of TS Badminton or any of the owners of Terminus Badminton (Edward Levin, Taylor Wingler, Thomas Shek). The interpretation of any provision of this code/rule shall be final.
