



## Terminus Badminton

### Player Policy

#### Scheduling

- There are two types of Player sessions: Directed sessions and Open sessions.
  - **Directed Sessions** are coordinated by Terminus Badminton and involve 6 person groups with built-in rotation after every match. Groups are created by the managers of Terminus Badminton and are based on skill level. There is a standard of shuttles used, which will be paid for (by shuttle used) at the end of the session. These shuttles are maintained (steamed and stored properly) by Terminus Badminton.
  - **Open Sessions** are scheduled by Terminus Badminton, but do not have a cap on players. These Sessions have the choice of purchasing individual shuttles to keep a high standard of shuttle or provide their own. Rotation of players is controlled by each group themselves.
- In case a visitor comes from out of town to play at Terminus Badminton our members always show inclusivity and allow the player to play for the day in either a managed or unmanaged session.
- When Volleyball season starts to pick up, Terminus Badminton will need to reschedule group sessions. Terminus Badminton will do its best to find another facility to accommodate players during certain high capacity Volleyball months.
- Group sessions are not canceled due to inclement weather unless an official notice from Terminus Badminton is released.
- Sessions start on-time and will not have added time if players are late.

#### Fees

- Directed session
  - The cost per player is \$15 for the session (1.5hrs)
  - Shuttles will cost \$2.50 per shuttle. (maintained and steamed).
- Open session
  - The cost per group is \$60 regardless of the number of players for the session (1.5hrs).
  - One designated player will pay Terminus Badminton. Internal split between group members will be handled on their own.
- Payment
  - Payment can be done by credit card (3% fee), cash, or check on the day of the session. Payment made before play.
  - Checks need to be made to Terminus Sports LLC

#### Code of Conduct

- Terminus Badminton maintains an environment of respect and compassion in all of our events/clinics/lessons/sessions.



- All students, members, and visitors that are utilizing our facilities must adhere to all rules and policies and are expected to act in a safe, courteous, and respectful manner at all times.
- All requests and instructions by Terminus Badminton staff should be strictly followed and failure to do so may result in any person, including members, being directed to leave the premises.
- Since group sessions will be scheduled at the same time as TS Badminton Academy coaching sessions, please show respect to students and mind your language during play.

**Prohibited conduct at Terminus Badminton during on or off-premises includes, but is not limited to, the following:**

- Foul, profane, or abusive language toward another person.
- Theft of any property
- Damaging the facilities of Terminus Badminton and the A5 Sportsplex in any way
- Threatening, harassing or intimidating any staff person, member, student, or visitor.
- Use of illegal drugs
- Possession of guns, knives, or other weapons
- Smoking
- Providing false information or records to Terminus Badminton, Terminus Sports, or A5 Sportsplex
- Selling products or conducting business without consent of Terminus Badminton
- Additionally, any criminal activity or acts or threats of violence may be reported to the proper authorities and prosecuted.

Terminus Badminton and TS Badminton reserve the right to deny, suspend, revoke or limit access to events or facilities at its sole discretion in the case of any violation of this code of conduct or any rule or policy of the A5 Sportsplex, consistent with applicable law. Any questions arising regarding the meaning of any of the above rules should be brought to the attention of either the Head Coach (Thomas Shek) of TS Badminton or any of the owners of Terminus Badminton (Edward Levin, Taylor Wingler, Thomas Shek). The interpretation of any provision of this code/rule shall be final.
